Title: Powder Coat Paint Line Technician
(Business - Medical Equipment & Bathroom Accessories Manufacturer)

Summary:

Job Responsibilities:

- Receive fabricated metal parts (variety of shapes/sizes) from the manufacturing machine shop
- Transport fabricated parts within the paint department using carts, pump truck and parts lifter
- Assemble the necessary equipment to hang fabricated parts on the paint booth wash line racking (each part is hung up individually on the racking)
- Overhead work to manually push a conveyor rack to wash line
- Operate a computer control for moving the racking through the wash line
- Ensure parts and racking complete the washline cycle and dry properly in order to prep for painting
- Setup of hand held paint gun
- Operate a hand held paint gun to apply powder coat paint to steel parts
- Exposure to confined spaces, chemicals and high heat
- Job setup using part jigs
- Use of power tools
- Grind bars that are used to hang parts
- Unwrap, sort, clean and wipe down steel parts
- **Performance targets (fast paced) related to time and quantity per part**
- General housekeeping
- Compliance with all safety guidelines
